Student Conduct

Rosters and attendance

- Students will receive one lesson per week which will be either a:
 - o **30 minute** class (if **2** students of the same level are put together)
 - o **45 minute** class (if **3** students of the same level are put together), or
 - 1-hour class (if 4 students of the same level are put together).
- Classical music lessons offered from Mondays to Wednesdays.
- Contemporary music (pop and rock) lessons offered from Wednesdays to Saturdays.
- Lesson fees are for the *time slot allocated* to the student *not for* specific music lessons. If a student cannot attend his/her class for any reason, the teacher is **not** obligated to make up the missed lesson. If you know you cannot make a class, please contact the Music Academy Administrator office on **012 368 2454** not less than 24 hours beforehand so that we can inform the teacher. No refunds given for cancelled or missed classes.
- If a student is unable to attend lessons, due to work commitment, sickness, outreaches, exams etc., the parent/student/guardian remains liable for the full term fee. Billing is NOT per lesson attended, but per term invoiced. In extreme, extenuating circumstances, the academy's principal will review individual cases.
- Teachers, at their own discretion, may give one catch-up lesson per term. If this lesson is not used it may not be transferred to another term, but is forfeited.
- Under no circumstances are regular or catch-up lessons given at a student's private residence.
- Hatfield Arts Centre reserves the right to appoint substitute teachers if the regular class teacher is unavailable
 due to illness or prior work-related engagements. If a substitute teacher is unavailable, the usual teacher will reschedule a new lesson. Teacher sick leave is two lessons per year.
- The minimum requirement for acceptance into Hatfield Arts Centre; the student should have his or her own instrument at home. Practice at home is an essential part of the course.
- Students should be prepared when coming to class, and should arrive before their lesson in order to start promptly.
- Parents (or friends) may only sit in on the **first lesson.** The only exception will be if the teacher requests the parent to observe a class. Extra people in the class can become a distraction to the students.
- If a student wishes to cancel lessons for an extended period, but wishes to reserve the timeslot, the parent/student/guardian remains liable for the fees to ensure the availability of the timeslot when the student returns.

Cancellation of music lessons

- Viewed in the light that a student entered into a **one-year contract** with HAC.
- If a student wishes to cancel lessons, a completed **cancellation form** should reach the principal of the Arts Centre before the current term **closes**. If the cancellation has been approved the cancellation will only take effect from the **END** of the **CURRENT** term.

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- Should a parent/student/guardian fail to cancel as per the required time frame they will be held liable for the current term's fees as well as the next term's fees, whether they decide to attend the lessons or not.
- Cancellation forms are available from the Music Academy Reception.

Payment of Fees

- Lessons normally run in conjunction with academic school terms, with exceptions such as church conferences and public holidays. Please read the regular newsletters or visit our website for the term lesson dates.
- Lesson fees are payable termly in advance before the <u>second lesson</u> of each term, or a monthly minimum of R350 for the period Feb Nov 2019.
- Billing is per term although the registration is for a complete academic year. The total fees for 2019 are R3500 per student per instrument taken.
- Various payment methods are available to make music lessons more accessible and affordable to students. Options available: Debit Order/Cash/EFT/Credit Card.
- A standard MONTHLY, TERMLY or ANNUAL debit order is available. **Note:** A **NEW** debit order authorisation form is required each year. Contact <a href="https://https:
